We deliver in the following areas

A Education:

We advocate for the need for Girl-child education at least to secondary school level. We provide scholarships to children of the widows and the less privileged in the society.

B Health:

We provide skill acquisitions training, capacity building and development for widows and youths, financial supports, financial management training as well as provision of foods, clothing and shelter.

D Agriculture:

In the area of agriculture, we providing training to widows farmers in crop production, management and marketing; formation of farmers (widows) into Clusters; we provide capacity building in the areas of leadership, cooperation and record keeping, link the farmers to stakeholders forum and build capacity in the areas of gender and family budgeting

E Career Counseling:

In career counseling, we are developing the self-awareness of the students/ clients; provide professional course information for higher school leavers; provide labour market information for graduates and help clients in making decision and setting goals assist them in planning for job search.
